Sure, Shippo! ...





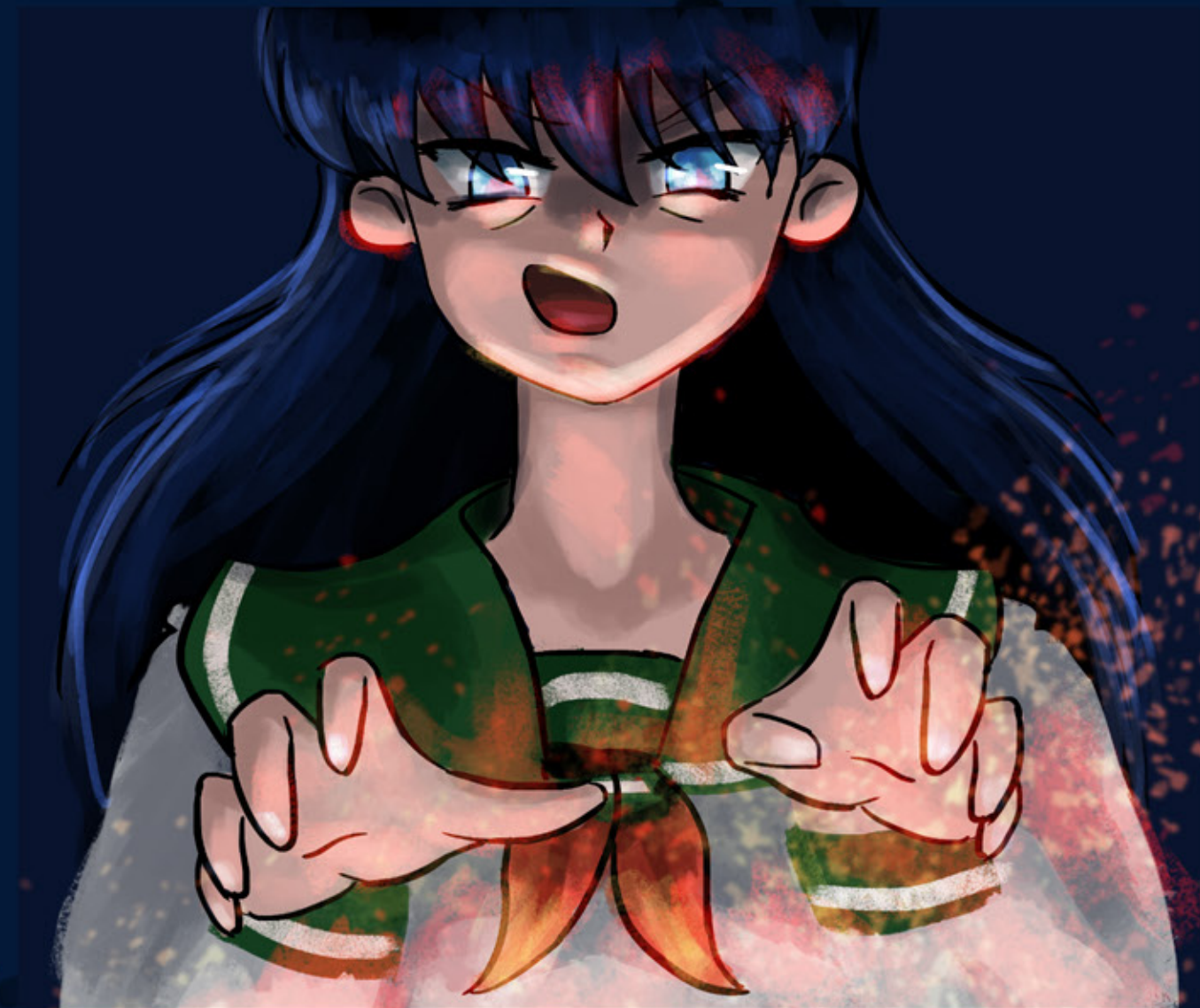
Do you know the

kuchisake-onna?



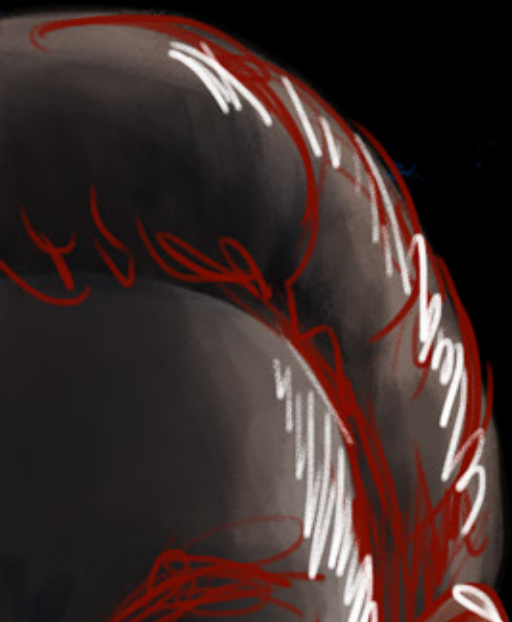
The slit-mouthed

appearance.

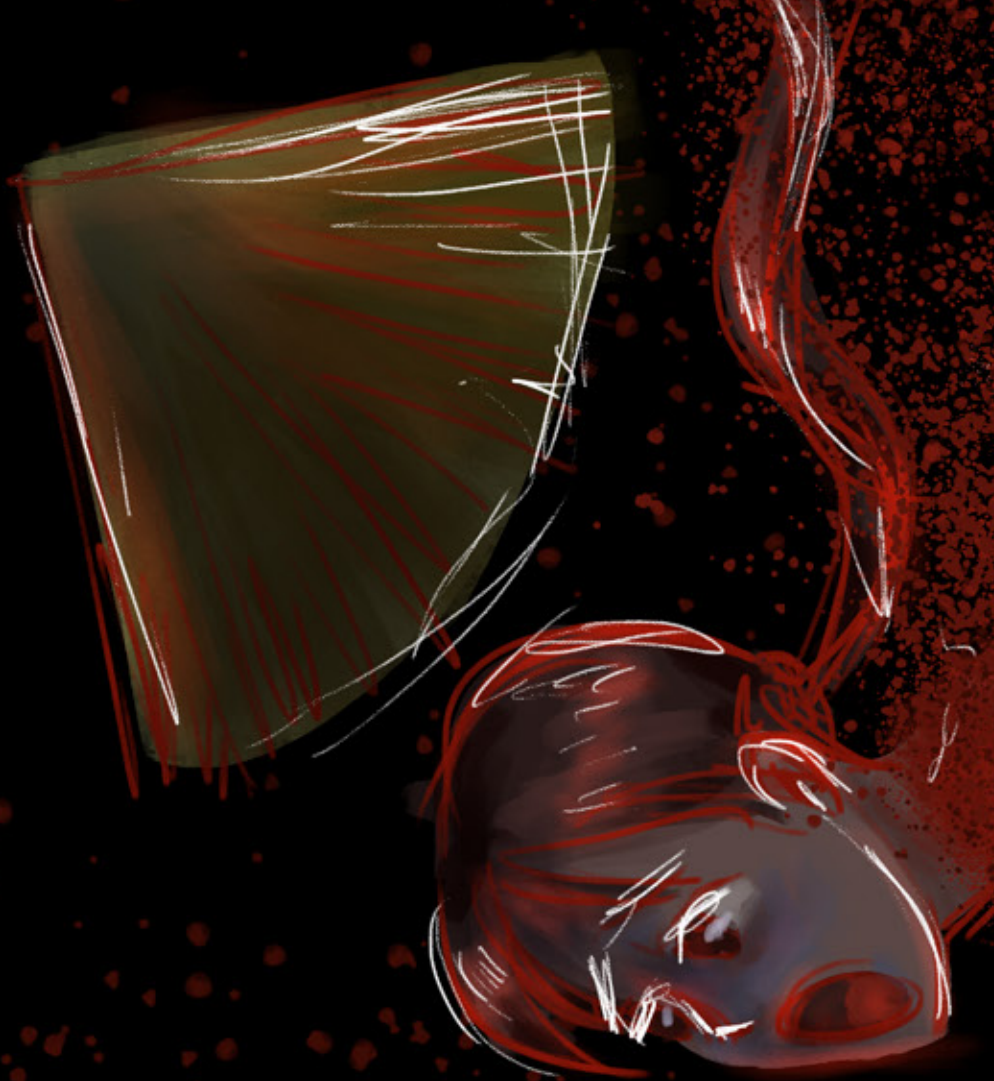

BEAUTIFUL?



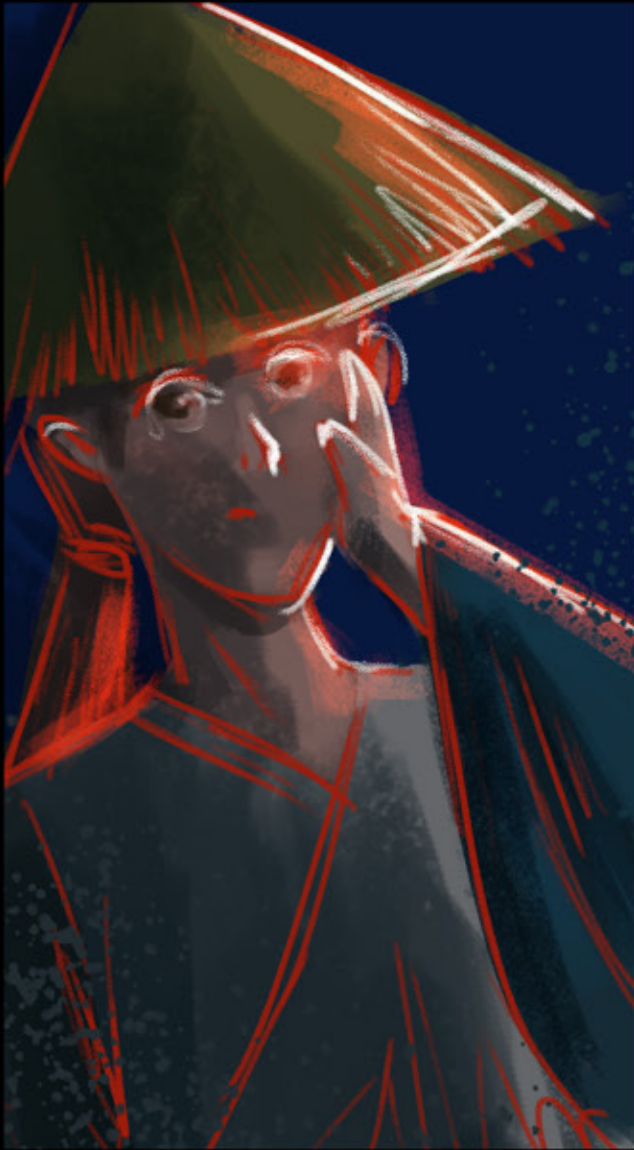
If they said,

AND

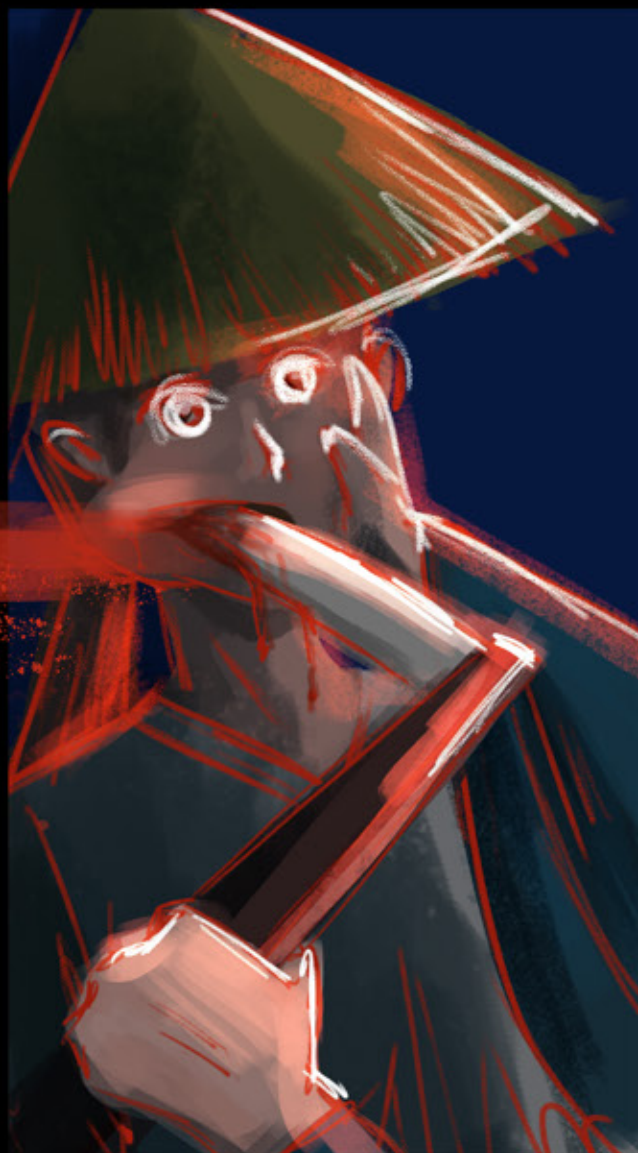
SLICE OFF

THEIR HEADS




If they said,
